Transport

A. Arrival at the Airport

Paris has two main airports:

- 1. Orly Airport, located about 10 miles south of Paris and 15 miles north of the campus.
- **2. Charles de Gaulle Airport**, also called Roissy Airport, is located some 15 miles north of Paris and 50 miles north of the campus.
- B. How to Reach the Campus
- 1. Public Transportation
 - a. How to Reach the Campus by Train
 - > From Roissy-Charles de Gaulle Airport

At the airport, take the RER B (Roissy-Rail, blue line) heading to Paris.

RER B Map

Get off at **Gare du Nord** station (also called **Paris Nord**). **On the opposite platform**, take the RER D (green line) heading to Corbeil-Essonnes or Malesherbes (<u>passing via Evry-Courcouronnes-Centre</u>).

Get off at the **Evry- Courcouronnes Central Station**. After leaving the platform by the turnstiles, turn left and exit the station. From there you can follow the signs to Institut Mines-Télécom Business School. It is a 5 to 10-minute walk.

Total Fare: about EUR 17.00.

Total Transit Time: One and a half hours.

> From Orly Airport

> Take Bus Number 285 to Reach Juvisy RER Station:

At Juvisy station, take the RER D (green line) heading to Corbeil-Essonnes (<u>passing via Evry-Courcouronnes-Centre</u>) or Malesherbes. Get off at the **Evry-Courcouronnes Central Station**. After going up the stairs and leaving the platform by the turnstiles, turn left and









exit the station. From there you can follow the signs to Telecom Ecole de Management or INT (previous name of TEM). It is a 5 to 10-minute walk.

> From Paris

From Paris, go to one of the following stations: Gare du Nord SNCF (also called Paris Nord), Châtelet-les-Halles RER on weekdays or Saturdays, or Gare de Lyon SNCF any day of the week. Take the RER D (green line) heading in the direction of Corbeil-Essonnes (passing via Evry-Courcouronnes-Centre) or in the direction of Malesherbes. Get off at the Evry-Courcouronnes Central Station.

Go up the stairs and upon passing the turnstiles to leave the train platform, turn left and exit the station. You will find signs showing the way to Telecom Ecole de Management or INT (previous name of TEM) which is a 5 to 10-minute walk.

Total Fare: less than EUR 10.00. **Total Transit Time:** 35 minutes.

2. Taxi

Taking a taxi, in France in general and in the Paris area in particular, is extremely expensive and should be reserved for those occasions when it is necessary. Tips of about 10 % are usually expected but not mandatory.

3. The Noctilien (Night Bus Service)

Noctilien is a night bus service that facilitates travel in and around Paris, in the Ile-de-France region. With Noctilien, you can travel throughout the greater Paris area all night long. This night service operates from 12:30 am to 5:30 am, 7 nights a week all year round. From Paris to Evry, you have to take the bus line number N144.
