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DESCRIPTION

ADM Valencia is a five-day international staff training week that aims to improve the key professional skills of Administration Staff from Higher Education Institutions. Participants will have the opportunity to work on their technical and social abilities in an authentic international setting.

INTENDED OUTCOMES

Upon completing the course, participants will have strengthened their communication and team-work skills, and increased their competence in the management of University Administration tasks.

EVENT STRUCTURE

The event lasts **25 hours**, divided into five hours of work sessions per day. **Fees: 400 €** per person, including work materials, welcome *paella* meal, and farewell lunch.

COACHING AND TRAINING METHODS

Small work groups will be created along the scheduled activities. Sessions involve specific

job shadowing (student affairs, human resources, finances and accountancy, accreditation and quality, institutional communication, among others), applied language and IT training, and topic-oriented coaching workshops.

- (1) Ten groups of participants will be created. Every group will be visiting five different ADM host teams over the week, each of them focusing on different administrative tasks and topics: student services, human resources, finances and accountancy, quality and accreditation, institutional communication.
- (2) Ten groups of participants will be created for joining one of the following courses: Spanish for Beginners (4 groups), English for University Staff- level B2 (4 groups) and Applied IT Tools for University Staff (2 groups)
- (3) Ten groups of participants will be created for joining one of the following workshops: A Mediterranean View, Spanish Food & Culture and Mediterranean Lifestyle.
- (4) Official Welcome, followed by a Courtesy Paella Meal
- (5) Introduction of selected ADM topics for a brief monitored open debate
- (6) Courtesy Farewell Lunch.

TRAINING COURSES (course offer may vary upon staff availability)

Language Training: Spanish for Beginners

Spanish for Beginners is an intensive five-hour crash course that aims to enhance the very basic communication skills of its participants. Sessions involve extremely applied oral and written language training, combining both individual and team work tasks.

Language Training: English for University Staff- level B2

English for University Staff – level B2 is an intensive five-hour course that aims to enhance the fluency of its participants. They will have the opportunity to work on their oral communication skills through specific learning tasks, vocabulary-building and pronunciation exercises.

IT Training: Applied IT Tools for University Staff

Applied IT Tools for University Staff is an intensive five-hour course that aims to give training in applied operative in two different areas:

1. Awareness about hidden risks for the unaware Internet users, with special focus on privacy

2. Helping you to create stunning presentations: discover the magnificent and attractive Prezi tool to make striking presentations beyond the traditional and sometimes boring PowerPoint framework



COACHING WORKSHOPS (workshop offer may vary upon staff availability)

Coaching Workshop I: A Mediterranean View / Mediterranean Lifestyle (Discover Valencia)

Reinforcing communication, creativity, teamwork among participants organized in small work groups for a challenging interactive development in a topic not directly related to their daily activities.

Discovering hidden places of Valencia, establishing a topic connection among them.

Enjoy Mediterranean life as the locals do. You will use your five senses to experience the most interesting places in Valencia. Each day you will participate in a different aspect of Spanish life. See where they work, shop, eat, relax and have fun. Coaching cases: Discover Valencia through smell, touch, taste, sound and feel. You will walk off the beaten path along quaint streets and open spaces, sit at bright terraces and shade yourself under 100 year old trees.

Coaching Workshop II: Spanish Food & Culture

Enhancing socio-cultural, leadership, product design and project management competences among participants organized in small work groups for a joint project in a topic not directly related to their daily activities: Spanish Food & Culture.

Coaching cases: culture at the table, culture of the street markets, culture and cuisine, wine & culture. Learning from professionals and sector stakeholders and creating a competitive and marketable start-up product.
