The Clinical Skills Lab (CSL) was founded in January 2007 with support of the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation. The Lab promotes learning, training and assessment of clinical skills (and other skills) in a protected environment, in a controlled and safe manner for the patient, and thereby contributes to clinical excellence. In pursuing its objectives, the CSL has three distinctive aspects: a wide portfolio of mannequins for training clinical gestures, a solid standardized patients program and an advanced simulation group, using high-fidelity simulators.
