It is our great pleasure to invite you to the 1st Erasmus+ International Conference and International Week on "Social Innovation and Volunteering: Active Learning Methodologies", which will take place between the 4th and the 8th of May 2020 in Barcelos, Portugal, organised by the School of Management of the Polytechnic of Cávado and Ave (IPCA).

A main goal of the International Week is to provide opportunities for Higher Education Institutions' stakeholders to share and discuss common concerns and experiences in the field of social innovation, volunteering and Active Learning Methodologies in education and business. This International Week is open to all areas of knowledge, for example Management, Law, Engineering, Design and Tourism among others.

The programme of activities will start with the *International Conference*, which is aimed at sharing and discussing research results and case studies on Social Innovation and Volunteering and different Active Learning Methodologies. The Conference intends to become a platform for good practices and innovative methodologies in higher education. The call for abstracts is open until the **2nd of March**. The International Week will bring to the discussion the perspectives of governmental entities (Panel I), academia (Panel II), business (Panel III) and Non-profit Organizations (Panel IV). Portuguese case studies will be shared and participants will have the opportunity to present their own cases/context by indicating in the application the panels (I, II, III, IV) they would like to actively participate in with a talk.

The last working day is dedicated to teaching staff interested in delivering lectures in the following subject areas:

This International Week, which is part of IPCA's School of Management internationalisation strategy, is also a great occasion to develop partnerships, make new contacts and to learn about our Institution, city, country, and culture while conducting teaching or training activities.

The Programme requires the payment of a *participation fee:*



- 120 euros per person, which includes materials, coffee breaks, welcome dinner and lunches according to the program as well as the registration fee for the International Conference.
- 60 euros per person only for the International Conference participation

Participants are expected to obtain Erasmus+ staff mobility grants from their home institutions to cover travel and accommodation expenses related to their participation.

How to submit abstract proposal?

The abstract submission will be made through the conference website. The Conference website will be announced soon.

Abstract rules

A concise and factual abstract is required (150 to 250 words). The abstract should state briefly the purpose of the research, the main results and major conclusions. An abstract is often presented separately from the article, so it must be able to stand-alone. For this reason, references should be avoided, but if essential, then cite the author(s) and year(s). Also, nonstandard abbreviations should be avoided, but if essential they must be defined at their first mention in the abstract itself.

Immediately after the abstract, provide a maximum of 5 keywords. These keywords will be used for indexing purposes.
