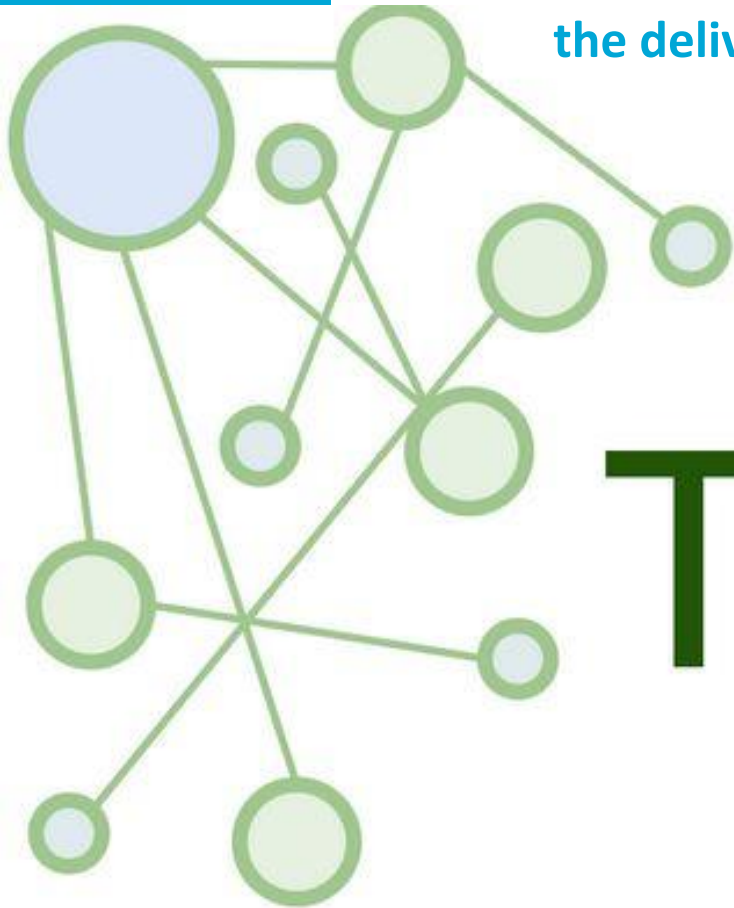

Tipasa, sometimes distinguished as Tipasa in Mauretania, was a colonia in the Roman province Mauretania Caesariensis, nowadays called Tipaza, and located in coastal central Algeria. Since 2002, it has been declared by UNESCO a "World Heritage Site".

- Also **externals** (UKB, OCLC) will be part of the cooperation

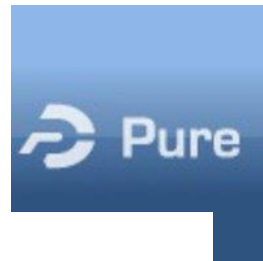

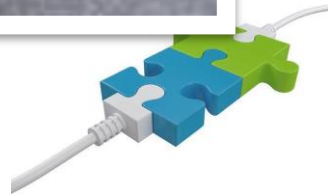

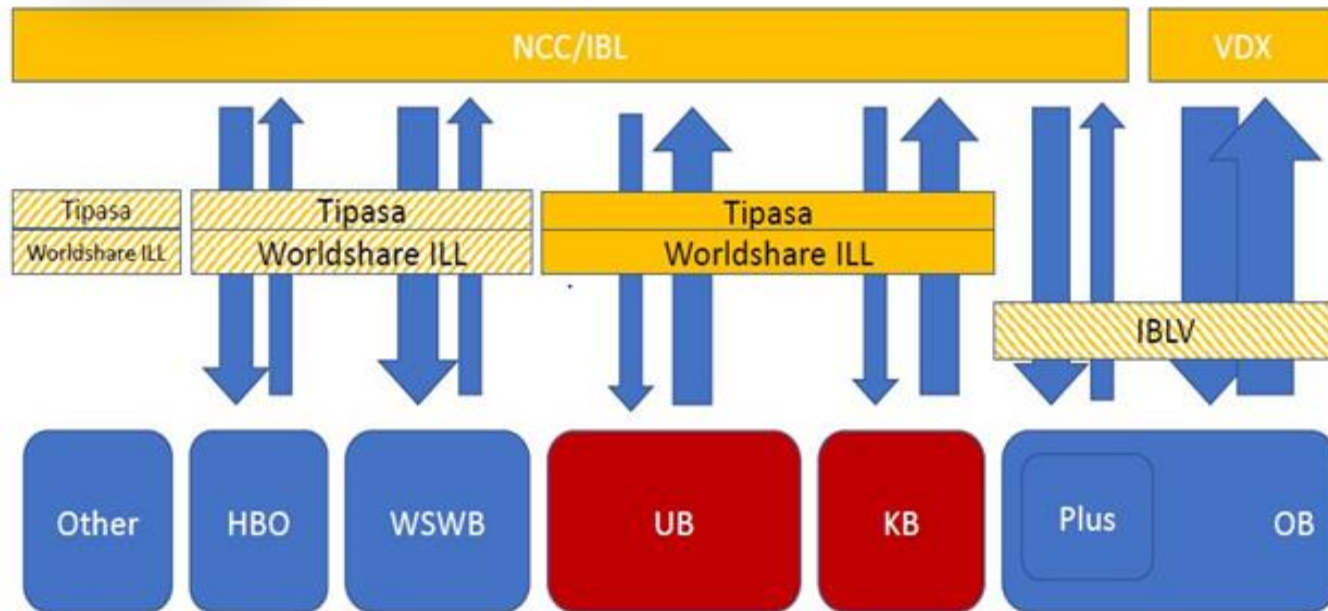

Introduction to Tipasa

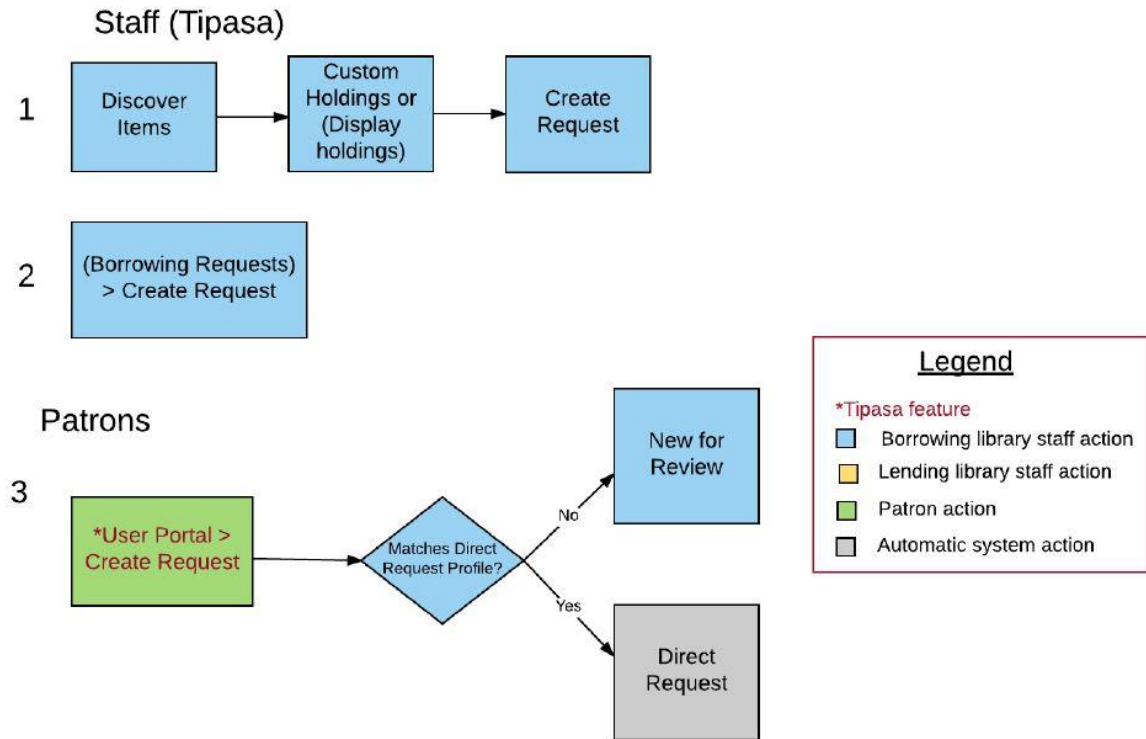
Tipasa provides new functionality that speeds fulfillment of interlibrary loan requests to save time for your staff and users.

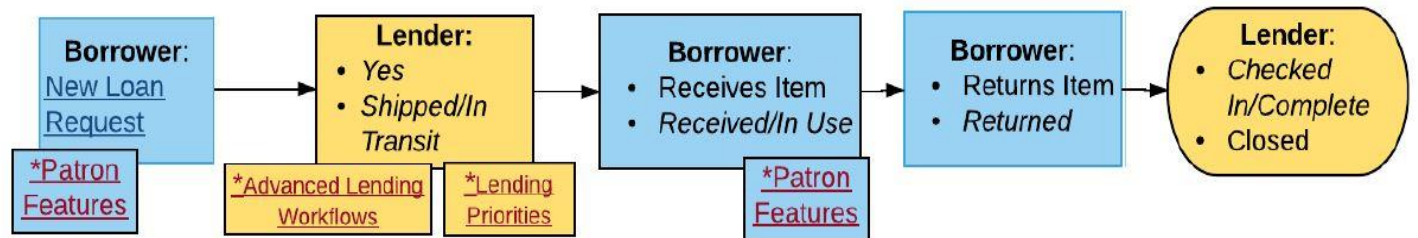

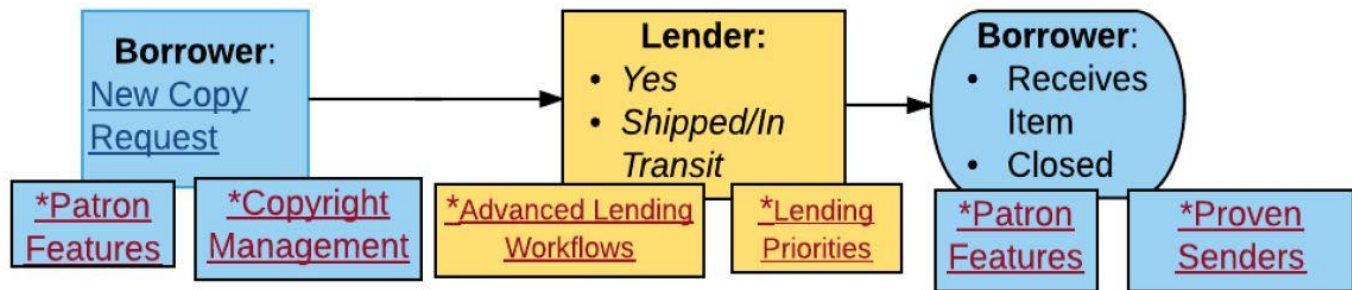

Borrowing from other libraries

Please note: This service is only available to TU Delft students and employees.

Are you looking for book that's not available in the [TU Delft Library collection](#)? In some cases we can arrange for it to be sent from another library. We refer to this as the Interlibrary Loan (ILL).

How it works

- Go to the [TU Delft catalog](#) and sign in. If the book is not available in the TU Delft Library collection, you can request it directly via the "Request item" button. All data will then be filled in automatically.
- You can also fill in [this online application form](#). Enter as many important data as possible, such as title, author, year of publication and ISBN.

You will receive an email once the book has arrived and you can collect it at the Library.

Ordering a copy or scan

Are you looking for an article, but it is not available online? Or would you like to make copies of a book that is not on loan? We are happy to make a copy or scan for you. Even when an article or book is not in our collection, in most cases we can arrange a copy or scan from a collection from another library. The documents are sent to you by email (pdf). This service is available to TU students and employees and non-profit organisations under the following conditions.

TU Delft students and employees

Are you looking for an article from our hardcopy collection, or would you like copies of certain pages from a book, and you are unable to come to the Library yourself? We can make a copy or a scan **for a fee**. The documents are sent to you by email (pdf). This service is free for TU Delft employees.

If an article is not available in our collection offline or online, in most cases we can arrange a copy or scan from a collection from another library. The documents will be delivered by mail (pdf). This service is **free of charge** for TU Delft employees and TU Delft students. Note: this does not apply to [borrowing books from another library](#).

Non-profit organisations

Are you looking for an article in our electronic or paper collection, or would you like a copy from a book? We can make copies or a scan **for a fee**. The documents will be delivered via email (pdf). You need an [account](#) to make use of this service.


