What is a BIP?

BIP is a program offered by the International Relations Office as part of the "Erasmus+ Hybrid Intensive Programs" initiative.

The Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP) is a short mobility program cofunded by the European Union. It allows staff to engage in hybrid mobility abroad over a brief period of time (from 5 to 30 days).

It combines:

- A physical mobility abroad (from 5 to 30 days)
- A **virtual activity** before, during or after the physical mobility.

Participants in an Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program must receive an

Erasmus grant from their sending institutions.
