Human-based International Relations

Building advanced competences for International Officers

Description

IRO Valencia is a five-day international **training and coaching** event that aims to improve the key professional skills of Int. Officers from ETSIAMN Partner Institutions. Participants will have the opportunity to work on their technical and social abilities in an authentic international setting.

Intended outcomes

Upon completing the course, participants will have strengthened their planning, leadership, management, team-building and decision-making skills, and increased their competence in University International Relations, both at institutional and personal level.

Event structure

The event lasts 25 hours, divided into five hours of work sessions per day. Fees: 380 € per person, including work materials, welcome *paella* meal, guided visit on the UPV campus, and farewell lunch. Extracurricular activities (not included in course fees): guided tour in old town Valencia, Spanish food cooking session and Valencia Fallas visit.

Event coordinator

Prof. Dr. Francisco Rovira, Head of International Relations ETSIAMN. Coaches and Lecturers are qualified Staff and Faculty from different UPV Schools and Departments.

Coaching and training methods

Small work groups are created along the scheduled activities. Sessions involve specific coaching workshops, group dynamics, topic oriented seminars, open debate, applied language and IT training, team work, and a powerful human-based operative framework.

Good-morning meetings: topic-oriented seminars for International Officers/Coordinators

Coaching Workshop I: *Photo & GIS throughout Valencia*

Reinforcing communication, creativity, team work and IT-competences among participants organized in small work groups for a challenging interactive development in a topic not directly related to their daily activities as International Officers and/or Coordinators: Mobile Applications and GIS systems.

Coaching case: discovering amazing hidden places of Valencia, establishing a topic connection among them, capturing images with the help of mobile devices, transferring them online to a server with the help of GIS software, and creating an interactive presentation with the selected materials.

Coaching Workshop II: *Spanish Food & Culture*

Enhancing socio-cultural, leadership, product design and project management competences among participants organized in small work groups for a joint project in a topic not directly related to their daily activities as International Officers and/or Coordinators: Spanish Food & Culture.

Coaching cases: culture at the table, culture of the street markets, culture and cuisine, wine & culture. Learning from professionals and sector stakeholders and creating a competitive and marketable start-up product.

Language Training: *Spanish for Beginners*

Spanish for Beginners is an intensive five-hour crash course that aims to enhance the very basic communication skills of its participants. Sessions involve extremely applied oral and written language training, combining both individual and team work tasks

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IT Training: *Applied IT Tools for University Staff*

Applied IT Tools for University Staff is an intensive five-hour course that aims to give training in applied operative in two different areas: 1) Awareness about hidden risks for the unaware Internet users, with practical security mini-lab. 2) Helping you to create stunning presentations: discover the magnificent and attractive Prezi tool to make striking presentations beyond the traditional and sometimes boring PowerPoint framework

Paula's Seminars: monitored group dynamics in key interpersonal communication aspects
