The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), also known as the Global Goals, were adopted by the United Nations in 2015 as a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure that by 2030 all people enjoy peace and prosperity.

The 17 SDGs are integrated—they recognize that action in one area will affect outcomes in others, and that development must balance social, economic and environmental sustainability. **Tenerife** is one of the eight Canary Islands, considered EU peripheral region. Discover with us in a practical way, how Tenerife is adapting to the United Nations SDG, the fragile environment, challenges, innovation and projects in this remote region of the Atlantic Ocean.

During the four days training in Tenerife the participants will discover the actions and projects that Tenerife is following towards *gender equity, accessibility, regenerative economy, good health and well-being, and renewable energies.*

Every single day <u>we travel around to discover</u> in different locations, visiting institutions, companies, associations and stakeholders cooperating and sharing best practices on *sustainable tourism*, regenerative tourism, conscious hiking, and integrating society by using green energy.

- To know practical examples of good practices following the SDG main objectives.
- To identify challenges and opportunities for advancing an integrated approach
- Nature connection and environmental consciousness
- To build professionals relationships and connections
- To embrace the essence of slow paced and eco-conscious journeys
- To learn about slow tourism and responsible travel in a fragile tourism destination.
