The University of Thessaly is situated in the region of Thessaly, Greece. The university's administration offices are located in Volos, but there are campuses in other major cities in Thessaly, Larissa, Trikala, Karditsa and Lamia, as well as in Volos.

The University of Thessaly was founded in 1984. The university comprises of eight faculties (School of Humanities and Social Sciences - School of Engineering - School of Economic and Administrative Studies - School of Health Sciences - School of Agricultural Sciences - School of Sciences - School of Physical Education, Sport Science and Dietics - School of Technology). It is divided into 35 departments offering undergraduate and postgraduate degree programmes.

Volos is a coastal city in Thessaly situated midway on the Greek mainland, about 326 kilometres north of Athens and 215 kilometres south of Thessaloniki. It is the capital of the Magnesia regional unit. It is built at the innermost point of the Pagasitikos Gulf and at the foot of Mount Pelion, the land of the Centaurs.
