The libraries of Dublin City University, Dublin Institute of Technology, Maynooth University, National Library of Ireland, Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland, University College Dublin and University of Dublin, Trinity College have come together to provide a dynamic and engaging programme of training for library colleagues under the ERASMUS scheme.

Target group	<p>Professional library staff with varied backgrounds working in universities or other research orientated libraries with an interest in sharing ideas and networking with colleagues.</p> <p>All participants must be awarded ERASMUS funding from their home institutions.</p>

Application Process	The application period closes at 17:00, <b>Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2017</b> . The applications will be assessed based on the applicant's motivation statement, professional biography and the applicant's own contribution to the programme (sharing ideas, best practice <i>etc.</i> ).  All applicants will be informed by e-mail by <b>Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2017</b> whether their application was approved or not.
Costs	Participation in the scheduled programme is free of charge. The programme includes lunch in the host institutions and one evening meal (Wednesday). Other costs such as accommodation; travel to and in Dublin; and other meals are to be covered by the participants.
Accommodation	Participants must organise their own accommodation and are responsible for covering their own accommodation costs.
