Here's a typical day in our program:

- **Evening:** Social gatherings

*We recommend this course to participants in good physical conditions to be ready to hike distances between 3 Km to 5 Km per day.

ACCOMMODATION

- Participants will stay in single-occupancy tents. Shared shower facilities are available. The common large tent is equipped with a refrigerator, power outlets, and internet access.
- A camping tent and sleeping bag will be provided for the duration of the camp. The tents are single-occupancy, and everyone is required to stay individually.
- A mat will be provided inside the tent for you to lie on. You can also bring a small pillow if you wish.
