








Located on the campus of a fine business university, we can take advantage of the surroundings like cafeteria, library, dormitories, support staff, etc., focusing our attention to our core competencies.














Our brand new multi-functional classroom is located in a business center in a 3- minute walking distance from the university, which again gives us easy access to extra facilities. The business center has a fully equipped conference room that we use for larger events and a cafeteria. We can also take advantage of the other tenants, for example, the fitness center is giving discounts to our staff and students and there's children daycare center.









Everything is provided by the college professional cosmetics and equipment for facial procedures, body treatments, manicure and pedicure, waxing, professional makeup, eyelash extensions, micropigmentation materials, mesotherapy materials, working robe or t-shirt, towels, gloves for treatments (face, body), disposable hygiene products (caps, gloves, panties, etc.), disinfectants, disposable nail files, tweezers, magnifier lamps, paraffin baths, hot stones, etc. The only materials we ask students to buy separately are makeup brushes and manicure tongs. We only use professional cosmetics and equipment.
