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

With a vast experience in the field of Education for Citizenship, Marta Uva participated as trainer in several Training Workshops "Education, Gender and Citizenship", with a specific focus in the area of gender equality, promoted by the General Directorate of Education and by the Citizenship and Equality Commission of Gender (CIG). Nejla Kalajdžisalihović, University of Sarajevo

Nejla Kalajdžisalihović is an Associate Professor at the University of Sarajevo—Faculty of Philosophy, Department of English Language and Literature (Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina). She has published (as an author or co-author) more than 25 papers in different local and international journals and three books (Primjena lingvističkih znanja u atribuciji i usporedbi autorstva: prilog teoriji i praksi (2021), and English in Aviation—A Content and Language Integrated Approach (2022) as well as Introduction to Psycholinguistics — Selected Readings (2023), with Aneta Naumoska). Until 2024, she has participated in three Erasmus + mobilities (Matej Bel University in Banska Bystrica, University of Warsaw in Warsaw, University of Macedonia in Thessaloniki). She has also participated in several projects co-ordinated by the European Centre for Modern Languages (Graz, Austria), as well as projects organized and co-ordinated by TPO Foundation and UNICEF. She is also a member of *The Society for* the Advancement of Applied Linguistics in Bosnia and Herzegovina (SAALinBiH), the Society for the Study of English in Bosnia and Herzegoving and International Association for the Educational Role of Language (Gdańsk, Poland).

Miroslav Hudec, VSB - Technical University of Ostrava

Miroslav Hudec is an associate professor at the VSB - Technical University of Ostrava, Czech Republic and at the University of Economics in Bratislava, Slovakia. His work focusses mainly on fuzzy logic, knowledge discovery, aggregation functions, business intelligence, and computational intelligence. He published (among others) seven articles in journals ranked Q1 in WoS and a monograph in Springer. He received PhD degree in Operational Research from the University of Belgrade, where he was recently got a position of visiting professor. Miroslav was also a visiting professor at the Medical University Graz, Austria (2020-2022). He serves as an associate editor in the journals Applied Soft Computing and International Journal of Interactive *Multimedia and Artificial Intelligence* (both ranked Q1 in WoS). He is cooperating, among others, with the Bern University of Applied Sciences on improving referendum voting in Switzerland by the principles of fuzzy logic and with the University of Fribourg on citizens participation in smart cities. He teaches courses Business Intelligence, Fuzzy Logic, Knowledge Discovery by Computational Intelligence, and Data mining. In the frame of Erasmus (and other programmes) he gave lectures at the University of Granada (Spain), University of Akureyri (Iceland), Abo Akademy University (Finland), University of Donja Gorica (Montenegro), University of Belgrade (Serbia), Kyushu Institute of Technology (Japan), Vilnius University (Lithuania), and University of Latvia (Latvia).

Nuno Jorge, Polytechnic University of Santarém PhD (2012), Master (2002) and Bachelor (1997) in Sociology.

Associate Professor at Management and Technology School – Santarém Polytechnic University (Portugal). Since 1998, lectures courses in Social Sciences, Sociology, Education, Organizational Behaviour, Social Economy and Research Methodologies, in Portuguese and English language.
