### By train:

Only two hours from Madrid! From the airport you will need to reach Chamartín Train Station. Take Metro line 8 or "Cercanías" train. Both AVE (high-speed-rail in Spain) and Alvia (long-distance rail) tickets are available at [www.renfe.es](http://www.renfe.es).

### By bus:

You can take a bus from Terminal 4 or reach the bus station by metro (Metro stop "Mendez Alvaro") and take a bus there. Bus tickets are available at [www.alsa.com](http://www.alsa.com).
