PROGRAMME

Guest lecturers have a choice to attend the event either on both campuses (transfer from Bordeaux to Lyon by plane being assured by BBA INSEEC) or to give lectures only at one location (ref. planning below):

- Bordeaux & Lyon campuses I 14 18 May 2018
- Bordeaux campus only I 14 16 May 2018
- x Lyon campus only I 16 18 May 2018

We do recommend participants to stay a minimum of three days and to give lectures on a mutually agreed topic(s): Marketing, Finance, Business Management, Entrepreunership, Ebusiness, Interactive Business English etc.

Guest lecturers are invited to suggest their study topics within the area of their expertise.

Teaching staff participants travelling within Erasmus are expected to give eight teaching hours in order to meet the minimum requirement.

The individual academic working frame would include:

- an academic module (2*3h) with an evaluation (0.5h) to be defined once a teaching topic is agreed;
- a participation in Company Setting-up Challenge as Jury

The working language of the week is English.

FINANCIAL ISSUES

REGISTRATION FEE: no fee applied.

For non-EU Partners, financial issues will have to be discussed bilaterally.
