It is also a way of strengthening a fruitful collaboration with Partner Universities by encouraging a teaching mobility. In addition to the lectures, opportunities to socialize with BBA INSEEC administrative and academic staff are also a part of programme.

The IW2019 event invites all participants to discuss, try out and share current trends, topics and models for developing education in the field of business.

The International Week in France would not be only a great opportunity to get to know our institution but also to experience the French culture and way of life.

We will arrange social activities (dinners, workshops) to offer participants networking informal conditions.

### **PROGRAMME**

Guest lecturers have a choice to attend the event either on both campuses (transfer from Lyon to Bordeaux by plane being assured by BBA INSEEC) or to give lectures only at one location (ref. planning below):

Lyon - Bordeaux campuses | 13 -17 May 2019 Lyon campus only | 13 - 15 May 2019 Bordeaux campus only | 15 - 17 May 2019

We do recommend participants to stay a minimum of three days and to give lectures on a mutually agreed topic(s): Marketing, Finance, Business Management, Entrepreunership, E-business, Interactive Business English, European, Institutions etc.

Guest lecturers are invited to suggest their study topics within the area of their expertise.

Teaching staff participants travelling within Erasmus are expected to give eight teaching hours in order to meet the minimum requirement.

The individual academic working frame would include:

- an academic module (2\*3h) with an evaluation (0.5h) to be defined once a teaching topic is agreed;

- a participation in Academic Challenge Activity as Jury Member. The working language of the week is **English**.
