We do recommend participants to stay a minimum of three days and to give lectures on a mutually agreed topic(s) : Marketing, Finance, Business Management, Entrepreunership, E-business, Interactive Business English, European, Institutions etc.

Guest lecturers are invited to suggest their study topics within the area of their expertise.

Teaching staff participants travelling within Erasmus are expected to give eight teaching hours in order to meet the minimum requirement.

The individual academic working frame would include: - an academic module (2*3h) with an evaluation (0.5h) to be defined once a teaching topic is agreed;

- a participation in Academic Challenge Activity as Jury Member.

The working language of the week is English.
