PhD students may carry out a 5-month research period with academic recognition for their thesis in Humanities, Sciences, Forestry and Agriculture, Social and Legal Sciences, Health Sciences, Engineering and Architecture.

Students must send a detailed work plan which must be approved by the supervisor at the University of Valladolid.

4. Academic Staff

More than 50 departments in Humanities, Sciences, Forestry and Agriculture, Social and Legal Sciences, Health Sciences, Engineering and Architecture are open to receive incoming staff, either for teaching or training, for a 5-day Erasmus+ activity.

Requirements: English or Spanish (B2 level) and a detailed work plan approved prior to arrival.

5. Administrative Staff

The International Relations Office of the University of Valladolid organises every year a Staff Week for International Project Officers working at partner institutions in the UVA's ICM project.

The aim of this specific activity is to strengthen cooperation, to gain a deeper insight into the UVA's project, to work in academic recognition as well as in the internationalization of institutions and to visit UVA's centres and faculties.
