09.00-11.00	<p>Racialized Welfare Dynamics in Refugee Work – the Danish Case</p> <p>By Assistant Professor, Ph.D., Marta Padovan-Özdemir</p> <p>This lecture emanates from a curiosity towards the state-of-alert and fear of social downturn expressed by welfare professionals, policy makers, administrators and civil society organizations during the so-called 'refugee crisis' in the Summer and Fall 2015. Why this panic, when Denmark have had more than 40 years of experience with refugee reception? This lecture discusses historical continuities and discontinuities in representations of the refugee in Denmark 1978-2016, and illuminates the historical development of a racialized welfare dynamic responding to refugees with economic and pathological concerns for social degeneration.</p> <p>There will also be time for a cross-national comparative discussion on the state of affairs in welfare work responding to the arrival of refugees.</p> <p>Marta is the head of a new research programA, <i>Welfare work with refugees, immigrants and ethnic minorities</i>, which she will introduce to and open up a conversation about possible future collaboration.</p>	G.322ab
