We invite candidates to check the availability of such funding with their home institution. Please note that the Erasmus+ programme requires visiting lecturers **from partner universities** to give at least 8 hours of lectures or classes within the regular courses offered by the host university, some of which might be given under the form of research seminars or workshops.
