Prior to the course you are invited to complete a Needs Analysis which will help the Centre to meet the particular needs of participants.

This course provides an opportunity to familiarize yourself with latest innovations in English language teaching and in the use of English as a Medium of Instruction (E.M.I).

The course will culminate with a mini-conference scenario where participants and tutors will engage in panel discussions and presentations based on their learning experience on the course and how it has informed and impacted on their ongoing professional development.
