International Environment

Our University is proud to cooperate with numerous foreign universities in the field of scientific research as well as students exchange programmes.

Our full-time students (within BA, MA or PhD programmes) are eligible to take part in EU student exchange programme called **Erasmus+** and have a possibility to spend a semester or a year abroad on full scholarship in one of 30 European countries.

Kielce University of Technology takes part in **CEEPUS** programme (Central European Exchange Programme for University Studies) Its main activity are university networks operating joint programmes ideally leading to Joint Degrees, esp. Joint Doctoral Programmes. CEEPUS covers mobility grants for students within this framework.

Dozen of our students study abroad within the Erasmus+ and CEEPUS programmes.

Every year more and more foreign students decide to choose Kielce University of Technology as their study destination either on regular basis or as exchange students. Our incoming Erasmus+ students participate in Orientation Weeks and Integration Events which give them opportunity to get to know history, culture and traditions of our regions.

We also welcome several guest lecturers and visitors from abroad throughout a year.

Accommodation

Available in one of our six dormitories (cost: 90-100 EURO per month). Students stay in twin-bedded rooms with private bathrooms or shared ones. They have access to shared kitchen at each floor. Our dormitories are close to the Faculty buildings (only 2 minutes walking distance). The University campus is located in the centre of Kielce so all the facilities like shopping malls or sports centre, etc. are within reach.

Students have a 50% discount for public transport as well as other discounts for entries to a number of pubs, clubs, sport centers, cinemas, museums and other institutions. Average cost of living in Kielce (per month) is 250 EURO.
