ARRIVAL IN CARTAGENA Airport/ Railway / Bus

The two closest airports to the city of Cartagena are:

Murcia International Airport. You can connect with Cartagena with Taxi or private transfer (distance: 37 km / estimated travel time: 30 minutes). No public buses available on May.

→ Alicante-Elche Miguel Hernández Airport. To connect to Cartagena, you need a bus from the airport to Murcia Bus Station (distance: 75 km /estimated travel time: 50 m). Once there, you have to get a second bus which will connect you to Cartagena city (distance: 50 km /estimated travel time: 40 m).

STAYING IN CARTAGENA

The Region of Murcia is one of the 17 Spanish autonomous communities, located in the southeast of the country. It has a opulation of 1,511,251 inhabitants (INE, 2020) and is one of the largest producers of fruits, vegetables, and flowers in Europe. Its industry stands out for the petrochemical, energy, tourism, and food sectors.

Cartagena is a medium-sized city (around 215,000 inhabitants) located on the Mediterranean Sea, with more than 3.000 years of History. It is the second most important city in the region of Murcia.

Cartagena has a Mediterranean climate and is one of the sunniest cities in Spain with more than 300 days of sunshine a year.



ENTERTAINMENT

Sightseeing and activities in Cartagena

Cartagena's privileged and strategic geographic location, surrounded by five hills and on the shores of a safe harbour, has attracted numerous civilizations over the years.

It is a city with almost 3 thousand years of history that offers visitors a monumental testimony of its splendid past and exceptional historical heritage, in each of its corners, streets, and squares.

It is home to important archaeological ruins from the Punic, Roman, Byzantine, and ancient Christian periods. It is also an important point of reference for the peninsular modernists and has buildings of great beauty.

Cartagena offers a wide range of museums:

- -Museum of the Roman Theater
- -Archaeological Museum
- -National Underwater Archaeological Museum (ARQUA).
- -Regional Museum of Modern Art (MURAM).
- -Naval Museum.
- -Military Museum.

A few minutes from the city, there are beautiful coves and beaches of crystalline waters such as Cala Cortina, El Portús, the beaches of the Mar Menor, La Manga and Cabo de Palos with beautiful marine life and virgin beaches located in the regional park of Calblanque.

Its climate makes it an ideal place to practice water sports (diving, sailing, surfing, etc.) all year round.

SPANISH CULTURE

Festivities/ Gastronomy / Entertainment FESTIVITIES

Several festivities are held in Cartagena every year. The most famous and meaningful ones are "Carthaginians and Romans" and "Semana Santa" (Easter Holy Week).

Easter is the oldest of Cartagena's festivities and receives the largest number of visitors.



Carthaginians and Romans festival commemorates the conquest of the ancient Carthaginian city by the Romans. It is celebrated during the second half of September.



GASTRONOMY

Cartagena's cuisine is mainly based on seafood.

One of its main fish dishes is the Caldero, a rice dish made with rockfish. There is a wide range of fresh vegetable products from the countryside such as peas, tomatoes, artichokes and also beans which, once dried, are used for the preparation of a very important Cartagena dish: michirones.

Other typical dishes are rice with rabbit, dried salted fish and desserts such as arrope (pumpkin and fruits marinated in sugar), tocino de cielo and pan de Calatrava.

The most typical drink is asiático: coffee with condensed milk and liquor 43.

Health care:

EU citizens: you can go directly to a health center with your European Health Insurance Card or equivalent document.

Spanish electrical socket (Type C & F)



(Suggestion) Bring a plug converter

In Spain, Schuko (Type F) or Europlug (Type C) plugs are used. Schuko plugs have two cylindrical pins with a diameter of 4.8 mm and contacts at the top and bottom.

WI-FI:

All UPCT buildings have a common WI-FI network (OPEN-UPCT eduroam) which you can access with your university credentials. People who cannot connect to eduroam should connect to the "Invitados" network, and self-register there by entering their name and e-mail address. They will immediately receive an email with the access password.

The duration of the connection is 2 days, but no problem: when the connection expires, you can re-apply.

How to access to "Invitados"?

In order to access the "Invitados" network, once you are in the UPCT facilities, follow the steps below:

1. Activate Wi-Fi on the device you want to connect to and click on the "Invitados" network.

2. A web portal will automatically open where you can register by entering a valid email address. The password for access will be sent to this address, as well as the conditions of use and a link to the UPCT network access regulations. IMPORTANT: If you carry out the process more than once, only the last password assigned will be valid.

3. To connect to the network, no software installation is required; simply select the network again to open the web portal and click on "Inicie sesión" (Login). In a new window you will be able to enter your login credentials (email address and password).
